Players' eligibility:

- * **14&U category:** 1. Boys singles & doubles, born between 1st January 1997 & 31st December 2000 (and have reached their 11th birthday on or before the start of the Singles Main Draw of a tournament)
2. Girls singles & doubles, born between 1st January 1997 & 31st December 2000 (and have reached their 11th birthday on or before the start of the Singles Main Draw of a tournament)
- * **12&U category:** 1. Boys singles & doubles, born between 1st January 1999 & 31st December 2001 (and have reached their 10th birthday on or before the start of the Singles Main Draw of a tournament)
2. Girls singles & doubles, born between 1st January 1999 & 31st December 2001 (and have reached their 10th birthday on or before the start of the Singles Main Draw of a tournament)

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) is required for main draw players: **04 Players** in the 12&U and **04 players** in the 14&U and **1 official** coach per **visiting country for the duration of the tournament**. Additional visiting players, even accepted to play in the main Draw have to pay for their accommodation.

Coaches must have been nominated by the national association when submitting the players' entries. No other coaches shall be guaranteed hospitality.

NB: The Circuit is open for all African players (refer to the general rules and regulations)
