Players' eligibility:

Boys and Girls have reached their 11th birthday on or before the start of the tournament and are born between 1st January 2005 & 31st December 2008

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) is offered to players coming from countries other than the host nation for a maximum of **04 Boys and 04 Girls** and **1 official** coach per visiting country from dinner of the day preceding the 1st day of the tournament until breakfast of the day following the end of the tournament or the duration of the tournament. Coaches must have been nominated by their national association. Other players and coaches must pay their accommodation even accepted in the main draw. The Hospitality cannot be guaranteed to other coaches or accompanying persons.
