The following information concerns the ITF/CAT North African Teams' Junior Championships for 12 years & under 2017 to be held in Tunisia from 23rd to 27th April 2017.

Each Zone will organize its own Team Championship for the 12 years and under category for boys and girls and the **2 Best Teams** from each region will be qualified to compete at the Final Event of the 12 & Under African Junior Teams' Championships (AJTC – 12&U) that will take place during the first week of September 2017 in an North African country.

This Championship is organized under the authority of the Confederation of African Tennis (CAT) with the support of the International Tennis Federation (ITF).

Players' eligibility:

- Boys' Team 12 & Under: Born between 1st January 2005 and 31st December 2007
- Girls' Team 12 & Under: Born between 1st January 2005 and 31st December 2007

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) will be offered for each team (3 players +1 captain) from the dinner of arrival day (22nd April 2017) until breakfast of the departure day (28th April 2017). Captains should be accommodated two per room and players 3 per room. Rooms must have separate beds; under no circumstances can players or captains share a bed.

Captains must have been nominated by the national association when submitting the players' entries. No other persons shall be guaranteed hospitality.
