Players' eligibility:

- Boys' Team 12 & Under: Born between 1st January 2007 and 31st December 2009
- Girls' Team 12 & Under: Born between 1st January 2007 and 31st December 2009 Players must have turned 10 years old prior or on the 1st day of the competition.

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) will be offered for each team (3 players +1 captain) from the dinner of arrival day (17th March) until breakfast of the departure day (23rd March 2019). Captains should be accommodated two per room and players 3 per room. Rooms must have separate beds; under no circumstances can players or captains share a bed.

Captains must have been nominated by their national association when submitting the players' entries. No other captains shall be guaranteed hospitality.
