Players' eligibility:

Boys and Girls, born between 1st January 2004 & 31st December 2007 (and have reached their 11th birthday on or before the start of the tournament)

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) is offered to players coming from countries other than the host nation for a maximum of **04 Boys and 04 Girls** and **1 official** coach per visiting country from dinner of the day preceding the 1st day of the tournament until breakfast of the day following the end of the tournament or the duration of the tournament.
