The ITF/CAT African Junior Championship for 14 years and Under on Clay Courts (AJCCC) 2018 will take place in Algiers - Algeria from 10 to 15 September 2018.

Participation Eligibility:

This Championship is open to African players of both genders, playing under the jurisdiction of their National Federations affiliated to the ITF and the CAT, holding a passport from an African country, born between the 1st January 2004 and the 31st December 2007 and had reached their 11th birthday before the Championships starting date, that is 10th September 2018.

Acceptance of players and entry methods:

- There is no Qualifications draw for the African Closed Junior Championships.
- Main draw for the girls as well as the boys : 32 players
- <u>Direct acceptance</u>:
- The 20 best players based on the 14 & U African ranking which will appear on <u>Monday</u> <u>20 August 2018</u> – 20 players totally.
- The 2 best players from each of the 4 African Regions (North, West & Central, East and Southern), entered at this Championship and ranked from the 21st place and over **8 players** totally.
- 2 Wild Cards* for the National players of the host nation.
- 2 Wild cards ** for the ITF/CAT.
- * The Wild Cards for the host nation (Algeria) could be allocated to the only Algerian players.

****** The ITF/CAT Wild Cards will be allocated by CAT in conjunction with the ITF Development Officers in Africa.

The ITF/CAT will accept the entries made by the National Tennis Federation and done through the Official Entry Form.

NB: The maximum number of players per Nations, excluding the host nation who will be accepted to participate at the AJCCC shall not exceed at any case five (5). Algeria could have a Maximum of 7 players (5 players eventually accepted among the best 20 Africans + 2 Wild cards) The Teams composed of 7 Players or more would be allowed to nominate a 2nd Coach.

Winner: 1000 – Runner up: 600 - ½ Finalists: 320 - ¼ Finalists: 200 – (For each player) No points for the CAT ranking will be awarded to a player in either singles or doubles until he/she played and won at least one match.

Entry Deadline:

The entries must be sent to the CAT no later than <u>Wednesday 15th August 2018 at 14:00 GMT</u>. Please note that entries must be completed through the official entry form. <u>NO ENTRY RECEIVED</u> AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE WILL BE ACCPETED.

Championships Committee:

- The referee.
- 2 ITF/CAT Representatives
- 1 Representative from the Algerian Tennis Federation.
- 3 accompanying team coaches (one representing the English speaking nations, 1 for the French speaking nations and 1 for the Arabic speaking nations).

The committee will assist the referee in making the draw for the events following the Rules & Regulations of the ITF/CAT Junior Circuit and will thereafter meet to establish the Championships program and settle any disputes. It will also decide on all matters concerning the rules and regulations.

General Rules:

- 1. All main draw events will be at the best of three sets and the tie-break system will operate in all sets. The Feed-in System will be adopted for Singles Girls and Boys Draws and on a "knock-out" system in the doubles. The AJCCC will be played during five (5) full days.
- 2. The ITF Junior Circuit Code of Conduct will be in force at the events and the competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the ITF/CAT Junior Circuit.
- 3. If a player fails to appear on the court within 15 minutes after his/her match is called, he/she will be disqualified
- 4. Customary dress code will be enforced
- 5. In entering the tournament, the players automatically grant, and without compensation, to the ITF, CAT and/or the Host nation and/or sponsors the right in perpetuity to use and to show pictures of him/her taken during the competition without compensation.
- 6. An Identity card or passport showing the date of birth for each player must be presented to the referee prior to the draw being made. <u>Any player not complying with the age of eligibility outlined above will not be able to participate in the competition</u>. In addition, any nation found to be in breach of this age eligibility rule will be eliminated from the competition and will face disciplinary action from the ITF.
- 7. The entry forms with the name and date of birth of each player, must be necessarily reach the CAT offices in Tunis no later than <u>Wednesday 15th August 2018</u>.
- 8. Any withdrawals must be submitted in writing direct to the CAT Office by Email: <u>issemessais@hotmail.com</u> before <u>Monday 27th August 2018</u>

Travel and Visas for Algeria:

Travel: All participating nations must make their own travel arrangements

Entry visa to Algeria :

Regarding the Entry Visa to Algeria, we have been advised by the following:

<u>Nationals of the following African countries do not require an entry visa to Algeria</u>: Libya, Mali, Morocco, Seychelles and Tunisia.

(This list of countries may be subject of modifications. It would be necessary to check prior with the ministry of Foreign Affairs of your country before travelling to Algeria)

Nationals of the following African countries requiring an entry visa to Algeria: All traveling African participants who do require an entry Visa to Algeria are responsible for either obtaining their visas in advance from the Algerian Embassy in their country of origin or neighboring country (An invitation letter will be sent to them by the Algerian Tennis Federation on request).
