ALL PLAYERS SELECTED FOR THE IAJCHC WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ACCEPTED IN THE MAIN DRAW OF THIS 14&U TOURNAMENT (WARM-UP). It is highly recommended that players selected to play the IAJCHC would take part to this warm-up tournament.

Players' eligibility:

Boys and Girls, born between 1st January 2005 & 31st December 2008 (and have reached their 11th birthday on or before the start of the tournament).

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) is offered to players coming from countries other than the host nation for a maximum of **04 Boys and 04 Girls** and **1 official** coach per visiting country from dinner of the day preceding the 1st day of the tournament until breakfast of the day following the end of the tournament. Coaches must have been nominated by their national association.

Exceptionally this year, and as this tournament will immediately precede the AJCHC, teams of 7 or 8 players who are all entered in the AJCHC will be allowed to have a 2nd coach who will receive full hospitality during the tournament.

Other players and coaches must pay their accommodation even accepted in the main draw. The Hospitality cannot be guaranteed to other coaches or accompanying persons.
