The tournament, The Petits As – Africa Playoffs in Singles Only is a qualifying event for the prestigious "Petits As" Tournament in Tarbes which will take place in January 2026, of Grade Super-Category in Tennis Europe Circuit.

The Petits As – Africa Playoffs 2025 will take place in Moundir Tennis Academy, Morocco from 10 to 14 November 2025.

<u>Accommodation</u>: Full hospitality will be provided for players and official coaches from dinner of 9 November to breakfast of 15 November 2025 for a maximum of 4 boys, 4 girls and 1 official coach per country.

All players and coaches will be accommodated in Doubles rooms with separate beds. The boys and girls will be accommodated in separate areas of the hotel. There will be no exception to this rule. Coaches should stay next to their team members at the hotel. They will be in charge to supervise them and they are entirely responsible for their behavior.

Acceptance of players and entry methods:

- Main draw for the girls as well as the boys: 32 players
- <u>Direct acceptance</u>:
- Among the entered players: The 18 best players born in 2012 and after based on the 14 & U African ranking which will appear on 20 October 2024 18 players in total.
- Among the entered players: The top two (2) players from each of the four regions (North, West & Center, East and South), ranked from 19th place and more, 8 players in total.
- 2 Wild Cards * for FRMT for national players from the host Country (Morocco) 2 players in total
- 2 Wild Cards ** for TFM 2 players in total
- 2 Wild Cards ** for CAT 2 players in total

Entries: All entries and withdrawals for this Tournament must be made online using the CAT ID identifier through http://www.cattennis.com/CTOF/login.php

Please note that each National Federation has an account with the CAT allowing it to have the right to review the registrations of its players for the tournament.

Entry Deadline

Entries must be made either online no later than **Tuesday 21 October 2025.**

Format of play:

- 1. Formation of 8 Pools of 4 players each with Round Robin matches. The seeding will be determined according to the African 14&U Ranking which appears on 9 November 2025.
- 2. The pools' matches will be played over three days with a possibility of playing 2 matches per day. However, the Main Draw Play Off matches as well as ranking matches will be played over two days with 2 matches per day.
- 3. All matches are played to the best of 2 sets with application of the decisive game when 6 games all. A Match Tie-break (Decisive Super Tie-break) will be used instead of the third set.
- 4. Short sets matches will be used in the ranking ties.
- 5. All Round Robin and Main Draw Play Off matches will be chair refereed and ranking matches may be refereed by Roving Referee.
- 6. In entering the tournament, the players automatically grant, and without compensation, to the FRMT, TFM & CAT and/or sponsors the right in perpetuity to use and to show pictures of him/her taken during the competition without compensation.
- 7. An Identity card or passport showing the date of birth for each player must be presented to the referee prior to the draw being made. Any player not complying with the age of eligibility outlined above will not be able to participate in the competition. In addition, any nation found to be in breach of this age eligibility rule will be eliminated from the competition.
- 8. Any withdrawals must be made online before Monday, 3 November 2025. After this date, any withdrawal must be made by sending an email to the Tournament Referee and the Tournament Administrator at the CAT.

Entry visa to Morocco:

All traveling African participants who do require an entry Visa for Morocco are responsible for either obtaining their **visas in advance** from the Moroccan Embassy in their country of origin or neighbor country (An invitation letter will be sent to them by the FRMT on request).
