GENERAL INFORMATION

Beginning of 2017, the ITF/CAT African Junior Circuit organized under the aegis of the Confederation of African Tennis (CAT) and the International Tennis Federation (ITF) will be reserved to **only the 14 and under age category**. The CAT plans to organize in collaboration with National Federations between February and August 2017 a series of 14 and under tournaments of Grade (1) as well as Grade (2). It is important to note that the selection of players who will take part in the 2nd African 14 and under Junior Championship to take place in September 2017 will be mainly based on the 14 and under African Ranking.

The following information concerns two legs of the ITF/CAT African Junior Circuit reserved to the 14 and under category only that will be held in **Nairobi – Kenya from the 01st to 07th May 2017**.

The first leg of Grade 2 will be held from 01st to 04th May 2017 followed by the second leg of Grade 2 from the 04th to 07th May 2017.

Players' eligibility:

Boys and Girls, born between 1st January 2003 & 31st December 2006 (and have reached their 11th birthday on or before the start of the tournament)

Hospitality:

Full hospitality (meals and accommodation) is offered to players coming from countries other than the host nation for a maximum of **04 Boys and 04 Girls** and **1 official** coach per visiting country ***from dinner of the day preceding the 1st day of the tournament (30th April) until breakfast of the day following the end of the tournament (08th May)***. Coaches must have been nominated by their national association. Other players and coaches must pay their accommodation and meals even accepted in the main draw. The Hospitality cannot be guaranteed to other coaches or accompanying persons.

NB : The main draw is limited to **32 players** only who will be accepted based on their African Ranking (see Rules and Regulations)

Transportation:

The Host Nation will offer **FREE** transportation if necessary from the official hotel to the venue and back. The Host Nation will also be in charge of the transfers from airport to the official hotel and back **ONLY** on the official arrival and departure days (on 30th April and 08th May). However, for early arrivals and late departures, the Host Nation might assist organizing the transportation **on the charges of the visiting teams**.
